ENTRIES CLOSE: JUNE 16, 2010 AT 4:30 P.M. (PDT)

CONDITIONS – The Sahalee Players Championship (SPC) Committee reserves the right to alter any of the conditions and schedules herein. The Committee reserves the right to rescind the invitation of any contestant, at any time, for any reason. Any decision by the Committee, in any matter, is final.

ELIGIBILITY – Entry into the championship is by invitation only.

ENTRIES – Invitees must enter the championship by completing and returning the Sahalee Players Championship entry form mailed with the invitation. Invitees may also enter online at www.sahaleeplayerschampionship.com beginning March 8, 2010. An entry fee of \$250 (U.S. funds) must accompany each entry form. Signed and completed entries, along with the appropriate fee, must be received by the Sahalee Players Championship Committee by 4:30 p.m. (PDT) on June 16, 2010. Late or incomplete entries or entries sent by telephone, e-mail, or fax will not be accepted. Entries should be mailed early to allow ample time for delay or error. The Sahalee Players Championship Committee, The Home Course, and Pacific Northwest Golf Association are not responsible for lost or misdirected mail. Refunds due to cancellation on or before June 28, 2010 are subject to a \$25 service fee. **NO REFUNDS WILL BE ISSUED AFTER JUNE 28, 2010.**

SCHEDULE – Competition will be over 72 holes of stroke play, gross scores only:

TUESDAY, JULY 6 - Practice Rounds.

WEDNESDAY, JULY 7 – (a.m.) First round, 18 holes; (p.m.) Second round, 18 holes.

THURSDAY, JULY 8 – (a.m.) Third round, 18 holes.

FRIDAY, JULY 9 – (a.m.) Fourth round, 18 holes.

Lowest scorer for 72 holes is champion. Any tie for lowest score will be played off hole-by-hole immediately following the completion of the fourth round until a champion is determined.

PRIVATE HOUSING - Private housing may be available for collegiate/junior players only and will be on a first-come, first-served basis. Housing is available only to the contestant himself, not his caddie or family. Players wishing to obtain private housing must indicate so on the entry form. All other players are responsible for making their own reservations for hotel accommodations.

REGISTRATION - All players must register on Tuesday, July 6 or Wednesday morning July 7. Registration will be located outside the PPGA Championship Trailer next to the golf shop and will be open Tuesday, July 6 beginning at 12:00 p.m.

CADDIES – A player may provide his own caddie. Players wishing to employ a host club caddie must make arrangements directly with the pro shop. Availability of host club caddies will be on a first-come, first-served basis.

PRACTICE ROUNDS – Contestants may play one complementary practice round on Tuesday, July 6 after 1:00 p.m. Local contestants are encouraged to play their practice round the week prior to the event at the discretion of the pro shop. Additional practice rounds may be played at the regular Home Course PPGA member rate. Please arrange your practice round starting time with The Home Course golf shop at (866) 964-0520.

HOTELS/ACCOMODATIONS – The SPC Committee has set up special rates at the following hotels, just minutes away from The Home Course (contestants should identify themselves as Sahalee Players Contestants when making reservations and must be made prior to June 15, 2010):

NON-METAL SPIKES – It is a condition of the Sahalee Players Championship that contestants not be permitted to wear traditional steel or ceramic-tipped spikes on their golf shoes during championship play (to include practice rounds). Contestants may wear any of the alternative forms of non-metal traction systems that will not penetrate or damage a putting green. **PENALTY FOR BREACH OF CONDITION: Disqualification.**

DRESS CODE – The following dress code applies to both players and caddies, and must be strictly adhered to: Tailored slacks or shorts, with a minimum 6" inseam, are acceptable. Shirts with collars are required, and must be worn at all times. Turtlenecks & mock turtlenecks are considered collars. Tank tops & tee shirts are prohibited. Denim pants, shorts, & cut-offs are prohibited at all times, in all areas. Athletic sweatshirts & athletic sweatpants are not allowed. Warm-up suits & fashion sweatshirts designed specifically for golf wear, such as those sold in the Pro Shop, are acceptable if worn with a collared shirt. Only golf shoes & tennis shoes are permitted on the golf course. Caps must be worn bill forward, and must not be worn in the clubhouse. Failure to comply with the dress code may result in disqualification from the Sahalee Players Championship.

TRANSPORTATION – Players must walk at all times during a stipulated round. **PENALTY FOR BREACH OF CONDITION: Two strokes for each hole at which any breach occurred; maximum penalty per round: Four strokes.** In the event of a breach between the play of two holes, the penalty applies to the next hole. Use of any unauthorized form of transportation must be discontinued immediately upon discovery that a breach has occurred. Otherwise, the player is disqualified.

ELECTRONIC DEVICES - The use of electronic devices, cellular phones, pagers, radios, ipods, walkmans, and any other similar electronic, noise-making device is prohibited during championship play. Clarifications and/or special requests regarding this condition should be directed to the SPC Committee in advance.

CLOSE OF COMPETITION – The competition is closed when all scores have been posted, the Committee has approved the results, and the championship trophy has been presented.
